Pool Clozing Checklist



Preparing the Water and Protecting the Pool

At Least 48 Hours Before Closing Your Pool:

- Bring a 1 liter water sample to your **Dazzle[™] Retailer**. Balance water for winter conditions. Water becomes more corrosive when cold. For better protection, increase the pH to 7.6 7.8 for closing with **Dazzle[™] pH Plus**.
- □ Clean your filter media with Dazzle[™] Rapid Action Filter Cleanse, following label directions.
- □ Following filter cleaning, deep cleanse water with Dazzle[™] Prep Cleanse. Shake well and add product through the skimmer. 1 bottle treats 80,000 litres.

Within 24 Hours of Closing Your Pool (these steps can be performed before or after lowering the water):

- □ Prevent stains and scale formation over winter; For fresh-water pools use Dazzle[™] Stain & Scale Cleanse. For salt water pools – use Pristiva[™] Primer. 1 bottle of either treats 80,000 litres.
- □ Remove organic wastes for clean, clear water; For fresh-water pools use DazzleTM Amaze Plus (1 pouch per 40,000 litres) or DazzleTM Ultra Shock. For salt pools use PristivaTM Premium Shock. Shock products can be pre-mixed with pool water and poured around edges of pool. Brush pool after application to ensure even mixing.
- □ For fresh-water pools; Prevent algae with Dazzle[™] Algae Resist 50 (60 ml per 10,000 litres) or Algae Clear 60 (100 ml per 10,000 litres). Apply directly to the pool, pouring around the edges and brush to mix.
- □ For added protection against algae for safety covers, use Dazzle[™] Phos Cleanse Plus by pouring directly into pool water. Shake well and triple rinse. Brush to mix. Consult your Dazzle[™] Retailer.
- □ Allow 1 hour between product additions unless more specific instructions say otherwise.

Prepare the Equipment and the Pool:

- □ Check the pool for broken or worn parts and replace if needed.
- Remove any leaves and physical debris using a leaf net. Brush pool walls thoroughly.
- Lower the water level by vacuuming to drain/waste.
 - In-ground pool: 1" below lowest return jet allowing all water to drain.
 - Above-ground pool: 18" below mouth of skimmer.

Note: When the water level falls below the skimmer mouth while vacuuming, a garden hose in the skimmer will help you maintain adequate suction and not lose prime in your pump.

- □ Clean the bathtub ring around the pool and the skimmer with **Dazzle[™] Surface Cleanse**.
- □ Clean out the skimmer basket and the pump's hair and lint basket.
- Remove and store skimmer basket, return fittings, ladder(s), diving board, underwater lights, auto cleaners, etc.
- Ensure all water has drained from pool return piping and plug. Remove all water from pool suction line and skimmer.
 - If necessary, blow out the water from your piping using an air blower (shop vac).

Remove drain plugs from pump, filter, heater, chlorinator and any other equipment.

Allow all water to drain. Once all the water has drained, apply a silicone lubricant to drain plugs and re-install (do not use lubricants on chlorinator drain plugs).

- <u>Filter:</u> Remove and store pressure gauge(s) and site glass and place filter dial valve in the winterize position. The drain plug should be left out to ensure proper draining.
- <u>Heater</u>: Check with your **Dazzle™ Retailer** for specific instructions on how to winterize your heater.
- <u>Pump</u>: Pour **DazzleTM** Premium Antifreeze into the wet-end of the pump. Lubricate the lid 'o'-ring with a silicone lubricant and re-install lid but do not tighten.
- <u>Automatic Chlorinators/Brominators:</u> Remove any remaining sanitizer and flush with water. Do not use antifreeze in automatic chlorinators/ brominators.
- <u>Salt Chlorinator</u>: Remove cell, clean with **Pristiva™ Salt Cell Cleaner** as per product label instructions. After cleaning, cell can be stored indoors. Cover open ends of piping where cell was installed to prevent unwanted entry.



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$\hfill\square$ Suction Line and Skimmer:

- If your pool has a functioning main drain line, put approximately three feet of foam rope down the main drain line (located in the skimmer). Plug it off with a rubber expandable plug or a threaded plug wrapped in teflon tape.
- Make sure any remaining water is completely out of the skimmer and suction line. Use a shop vac to ensure all water has been removed.
- Pour approximately two litres of **Dazzle™ Premium Antifreeze** down your suction line, then feed approximately two feet of foam rope down the suction line for best protection.
- Use a "gizzmo" to plug this line and absorb any expansion in the skimmer. Alternatively, consult your retailer on other plugs and methods of winterizing your skimmer.
- After the skimmer has been plugged and expansion device installed, pour additional Dazzle[™] Premium Antifreeze into the skimmer for extra protection.
- \Box Place winter cover on pool.
- Place water bags around cover: Place water bags through loops. Fill to approximately 50%, be careful not to over fill. Ideally, water bags should be touching end to end.
- Add 1" of water to the topside of the cover to help provide stability for windy days.
- □ Consult with your **DazzleTM Retailer** if a top-up amount of water is to be placed under the cover to raise the pool water level to the correct line for winter.
- □ Clean, protect and preserve your solar blanket by cleaning properly before storage with Dazzle[™] Cover Cleanse.

Note: Each pool is unique, for more comprehensive winterizing instructions, consult your Dazzle[™] Retailer.

If you are using a safety or mesh cover or no cover at all, re-treat with shock and algicide at the first thaw in the spring to reduce the risk of algae at opening. Consult your **Dazzle™ Retailer** on how best to do this. Always premix products when applying to cold water and when the pump/filter is not in operation and brush after addition.
